Ladies and Gentlemen, dear friends of SPIELART,

What's next? is a "generations of theater" project with mentors Romeo Castellucci, Tim Etchells, Jan Lauwers and Johan Simons, and with Orthographe, Simone Aughterlony, Maarten Seghers and Neco Çelik. SPIELART 2007 is examining the issues of the artists of tomorrow and thus the future of theater – with the presentation of new productions by young theater artists and with a dialogue between different generations.

Simone Aughterlony: TONIC

TONIC asks how one might find choreographic proposals to treat specific human complaints, both physical and emotional: Wouldn't it be nice if there were a movement recipe for each individual set of circumstances that offered an improvement by way of moving the body in space and time?

Neco Çelik: EXCLUDED by Xavier Durringer

EXCLUDED centers on the lives of the *beurs*, Arabian-born emigrants of the first, second and third generations. Durringer's characters do not speak for themselves, but rather they form a polyphonic choir of inhabitants of the suburban ghettos in French metropolises. They talk about the two shores of the Mediterranean Sea. about the train stations in Marseille and Paris. about dog fights and "bimbo bambule." about "croissant knights." about the female hashīsh sect, and about how "bearded men are the antithesis of shaved men." *SAT 24. 11., 21 Uhr, SO 25., FR 30. 11., und SA 1. 12., 20 Uhr, Münchner Kammerspiele,*

Maarten Seghers: SO MAN

So, man, a solo session. a fake bootleg. an hysterical attempt.One can hear a man saying: "I went down on a chicken earlier today..."
